MEASLES OUTBREAK

There has been a rapid rise in the number of measles cases reported around the country. Measles is a highly infectious notifiable disease with serious complications. Immunisation is free, and is the best way to prevent measles. Doctors have begun recalling unimmunised patients to increase immunisation coverage.

Parents / caregivers – please check that your children's immunisations are up-to-date. The Ministry of Health requires students who have no proven immunity to measles (through immunisation or previous exposure) to be sent home if there is a measles outbreak in their class.
