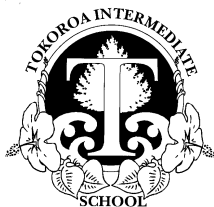

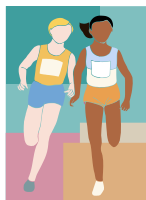
MUFTI DAY
